New security declaration for USA effective January, 29th 2016

Dear valued Swiss WorldCargo Customer,

Swiss WorldCargo attaches the utmost priority to ensuring the safe and reliable transport of cargo shipments. Its activities are firmly underpinned by numerous national and international as well as Lufthansa Cargo's own internal regulations, whose compliance is strictly monitored. These are updated regularly in accordance with and dependent on political and regulatory developments.

The United States Transportation Security Administration has issued a directive which requires an additional security declaration for all shipments bound for the United States. As a result, all shipments with air waybills issued no later than January 29th 2016 are to comply and include the following declaration:

"(Name of Entity) _____ has reviewed all available documentation and has determined that none of the cargo being offered in this consignment or consolidation either originated in, transferred from, or transited through any point in Egypt, Syria, Somalia or Yemen."

This security statement is in addition and does not replace any current declaration in place. The declaration can be made on a separate document, on the air waybill in the 'handling information box', in the OSI line within an eAWB or supplemental information on an already existing CSD or eCSD.
